# What is StoryCorps?

StoryCorps is a website and app that allows users to record and share interviews/stories. The organization's mission is "to preserve and share humanity's stories in order to build connections between people and create a more just and compassionate world."

## How can this tool be used?

### This app could be used

- in a history class to interview older adults about a previous time period
- in a career class to interview someone in a chosen career or job
- in an English class as part of a personal narrative



### Who should use it?

StoryCorps is recommended ONLY for high school students. Students MUST be at least 13 to use the app and website and must have parental permission if they are under 18. Caution and pre-teaching of safe internet usage is recommended before using the app.



### Privacy Information/CIPA/COPPA

StoryCorps treats all users (13-17 & adults) the same way.

Users are expected to follow the site's policies pertaining to appropriate content, but they do not always monitor or screen content, so user caution is recommended. Also, personally identifiable information is collected, but protected. Anything shared on the site can be used by StoryCorps and the creator no longer has exclusive rights to their creation.
